CDCHD1317 Various: Smash Boom Bang! The Songs And Productions Of Feldman-Goldstein-Gotteher. 26 classy sides from hot songwriting team that struck big in the mid-60s with Hang On, Sloopy by The McCoys, Tell Her by Dean Parrish and I Want Candy by The Strangeloves. These are all here alongside other rocking and gritty sides by The Angels, Ron Winters, Jerry Butler, Dion and more.

CDCHD1318 Various: The London American label Year By Year 1957. Latest in popular, but strangely non-sequential series, this has 28 hits from the original London label, remastered and many making their Ace CD debut. Focus here is on rock & roll and doo-wop with tracks by The Moonglows, Carl Perkins, Bill Haley, Chuck Berry, Fats Domino, Ruth Brown, Charlie Gracie and more. As always, great notes.

CDCHD1326 Johnny Otis: On The Show - The Johnny Otis Story Volume 2 1957-74. Hot on the heels of big-selling Volume 1 (Midnight At The Barrelhouse - CDCHD1312), this has 24 more enduring classics, including sides from his renaissance of popularity following 1969's Cold Shot album. This release co-incides of course with the very recent news of his passing earlier in January and is undoubtedly a fitting tribute.

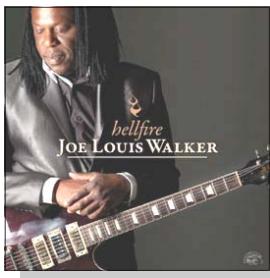

CDTOP2 1331 Eddie Holland: It Moves Me - The Complete Recordings 1958-64. The solo sides of one third of the legendary Holland-Dozier-Holland songwriting team. Disc one includes both sides of his 15 singles released 1958-64 on Mercury, Kudo, Tamla, United Artists and Motown prior to his withdrawing from the spotlight to focus on penning the hits for others; Disc two includes unissued masters from the Motown vaults, including titles written by Berry Gordon, Smokey Robinson, Norman Whitfield and, of course, Holland-Dozier-Holland. With great notes that include a rare interview with Eddie himself.

ALCD4945 Joe Louis Walker: Hellfire. Alligator debut album, produced by Grammy Award winner Tom Hambridge who has recently worked wonders for Buddy Guy, George Thorogood and Susan Tedeschi. Another blistering set of 11 songs from one of the best living blues musicians.

With 48 page booklet.

BCD17249AR Duane Eddy: Rocks. 32 tracks of reverb and tremolo that made the legend, recorded for JAMIE between 1958 and 1961. With a glorious 56 page booklet.

BCD15778EK Duane Eddy: Twangin' From Phoenix To L.A. - The Jamie Years. His entire JAMIE output, plus little-heard tracks recorded before his break-through in 1958, plus stereo alternate takes and some other extras missing from the first appearance of this deluxe collection in 1994. Includes a fabulous 84-page hardback book with essays, discography and exceptional photos.

BCD16944EK Red Simpson: Hello, I'm Red Simpson. Truck-driving West Coast country

singer full of anthems about life on the open road and what it does to a man. All of his recordings from 1957 to 1984, including his seven Capitol albums plus singles for other independents, alternate takes and other rarities. Bob Dylan called him the "forgotten man of the Bakersfield sound" and Merle Haggard and Buck Owens between them recorded 40 of his songs. With 167 tracks in all plus a 108 page book.

BHMCD69 Roxanne Potvin: Play. Fifth album from Juno-nominated singer-songwriter. Still based in the blues but with evidence of rock and pop as well this time.

BK051 Daniel Beaumont: Preachin' The Blues - The Life And Times Of Son House (hardback). A new biography that tackles the myths and legends as well as reports the known facts of the life and times of this genuine blues giant. This account is an admirably succinct read - critically questioning many of the long-established interpretations of the House story without tying it up into a revisionist theory. Good on his early recordings, his years away from the music scene and his so-called 'rediscovery' and final years. An enjoyable and important addition to blues scholarship.

ARROW BOOK £8.95 (+ £2.50 UK p&p)

BK052 John Szwed: The Man Who Recorded The World - A Biography Of Alan Lomax (paperback). The riveting story of a man who travelled with just his passion for finding new music and a tape recorder (and probably a bag for his change of pants and vest). As well as the awe-inspiring musical legacy his work created - discovering and recording Leadbelly, Jelly Roll Morton, Woody Guthrie, Muddy Waters and many more - this account incorporates his travel adventures and the impact it all had on his often-chaotic personal life and relationships. Impressively researched and well-written, this is a towering achievement.

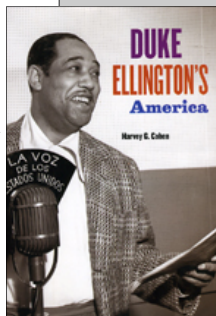

It's all here - his early friendships and musical enthusiasms, his travels through the burgeoning UK blues scene and the Yardbirds in the sixties and his various musical explorations and recordings since. Exclusive interviews with many close collaborators, pictures, album reviews and up-to-date discography, this is essential.

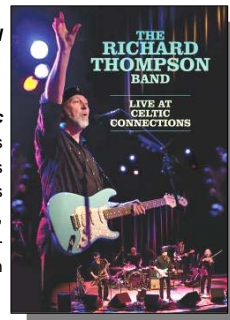

Given that Stiff Records was started up initially with a loan from Lee Brilleaux, it seems anomalous that the Feelgood's didn't actually record for the label until the it was in decline in the 80s. This set, originally released in 2005, captures their 2 albums for the label - *Brilleaux* (1986) and *Classic* (1987). Lee leads the band through some fine material - including covers of songs by John Hiatt, Johnny Cash, Bobby Charles and even the Undertones - which, despite the dated 80s production sheen, offers up loads of toe-tapping highlights.
