THEN PLAY ON...

Welcome to the second Red Lick catalite - for those not with us last month (or maybe just not fully paying attention), this is our new format of publication, not quite a catalogue but more than our previously issued between-catalogue new release sheets. Sort of a catalogue-lite, so to speak. Hence, a catalite!

By way of a reminder, we have introduced this to meet the future needs of the business and adjust to the realities of the 21st century. These include the realisation that we simply cannot justify an ongoing commitment to the production of a bulky, detailed and labour-intensive catalogue every other month. It is not just the cost (though rising print and postage costs do make that a factor) but the sheer number of hours involved in researching, writing and editing such a publication. Such an intensive commitment has not only prevented us from life's little luxuries (such as sleep, a relaxing pint here and there or an afternoon in the park with the children), but also impacted big-time on our ability to stay focussed on what matters most - servicing our customers, despatching orders as promptly as possible and generally keeping on top of things. It is fair to say that when we are full tilt in meeting the bi-monthly deadlines of getting the catalogue to print and posted out, we are severely restricted (for maybe a fortnight every other month) in our ability to keep up with the day-to-day of the operation of the business. If for no other reason, this has had to change.

Furthermore, we have been increasingly conscious of a major and fundamental weakness of the catalogue; that is, much of the editing of each edition has been concerned with the selection of what is to go in and what is to be left out of the next issue. Spending so much time deciding on what to exclude is, to our mind, nuts, especially as by spending so much time inhibiting the options available via the catalogue, we are unable to spend time opening up the possibilities of the website; effectively an on-line catalogue facility that does not have the inherent limitations of the traditional printed catalogue.

So, the plan from here on in is that the catalogue, as and when it does re-appear, will be a less frequent and less time-tabled occurrence. Rather we will concentrate on a more regular series of catalites and invest the time and money that previously would have gone into the catalogue into the further development of our website.

We deliberately timed the change at the end of the then current catalogue subscription year - now all subscriptions have run out, please do not send any money in to renew your catalogue subscription (as there now isn't one). We have reverted instead to a more subjective decision as to who 'qualifies' to be sent future mail-outs - this will be based on spending patterns over recent months. In simple terms, if you stop spending (either at all or in only minuscule amounts) you run the risk of falling off the mailing lists. Similarly, for those customers who have previously been paying the £1 to qualify for first class postage of the catalogue, this option has now been ended (on the basis that we are no longer strictly timetabling future catalites/catalogues).

We appreciate that there will be 'winners' and 'losers' in relation to these new arrangements but we do believe that the benefits going forward far out-weigh the (unrealistic) option of carrying on as before and changing nothing. We trust you appreciate, and even like, the changes as explained here. From the overwhelmingly positive and supportive comments generated from the March catalite, we already know we have your support and backing; something we appreciate very much.

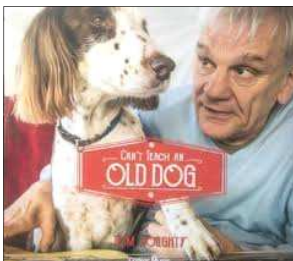

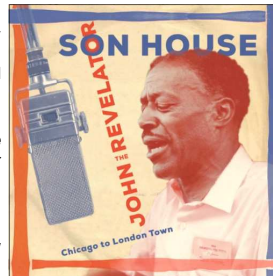

Lots of Dylan covers and other country-rock leanings from the period.

HCD7294 Steve Nelson: *Brothers Under The Sun*. An imaginative set led by vibist Steve Nelson offered as a tribute to his late collaborator, pianist Mulgrew Miller.

HB015 Ry Cooder: *The Complete Bottom Line Broadcast 1974*. Another chance to get this historic set in New York on 16th May. Seventeen majestic acoustic performances plus between song banter.

HOODOO CD £9.75

263562 Elvis Presley: *Mystery Train - The Sun Recordings*. 27 indispensable sides from 1953-1955 featuring the earth-shattering early singles, plus rarely heard demos and a few live sides from the same period. A must-have collection.

263567 Ivory Joe Hunter: *Rock & Roll*. Fabulous blues, R&B and boogie-woogie singer, songwriter, pianist and bandleader on his second album for Atlantic from 1957 produced by Jerry Wexler and Ahmet Ertegun featuring singles from 1954 - 1956. Also includes as a bonus 12 bonus tracks from the same period and just before.

263568 Dave 'Baby' Cortez: *The Happy Organ + Dave 'Baby' Cortez*. Leading figure in the popularisation of the Hammond organ featuring lots of examples of his talent for catchy hooks and soul and blues riffs. This includes his first two albums from 1959 and 1960 plus nine bonus tracks from the same period.

JASMC03084 John Lee Hooker: *Gotta Boogie, Gotta Sing*. Following *Blues In Transition 1955-59* (JASCD562), this set features the earlier recording career of the great man between 1948 and 1954. Fantastic sides, mostly solo, and a must for fans.

JASCD835 Stan Freberg And Friends: *The Old Payola Roll Blues and Other Hysterical Hits of the 50s*. One of the USA's foremost satirists of the 1950s with a load of his enormously funny satirical versions of pop hits of the day. Just as funny now.

JASMC03086 Muddy Waters, Howlin' Wolf & Little Walter: *The Chicago Super Blues Revisited - Singles As & Bs 1961-1962*. A bit misleading as this is not the 1960s collaborations that went under a similar title but separate recordings from the great trio. No matter, it does host fine lesser compiled sides including Muddy's *Muddy Waters Twist*, *You Need Love* and *You Shook Me*, Wolf's *I Ain't Superstitious* and *Do The Do* and Walter's *As Long As I Have You* and *Crazy Legs*.

JASCD963 Various: *Love Charms - West Coast Hits & Rarities From California Girls And Groups 1957-1962*. With 33 tracks featuring The Dreamers, The Dories, Cindy And Sue, The Blossoms, Timi Yuro, Carol Connors, Jackie DeShannon, Gloria Rose and more.

JASCD962 Ace Cannon: *Tuff Sax Of Ace Cannon*. Two albums from 1962 from popular alto saxophonist - *Tuff Sax* and *Looking Back*.

JASCD957 Various: *R&B Chart Makers with a Difference*. 24 great tracks that hit the charts between 1955 and 1962 featuring Everly Brothers, Eddie Cochran, Gene Vincent, The Chordettes, The Diamonds, Dion And The Belmonts and more.

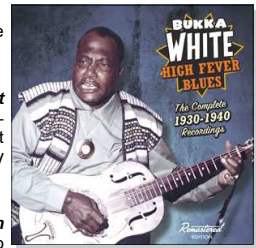

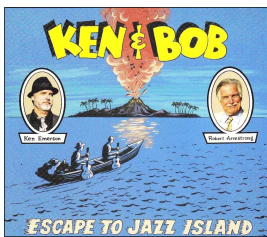
