BHCD0084 Joey Wright: *Country, Music*. New album from Juno-nominated singer-songwriter who has been a leading light of the Canadian bluegrass, old-time and traditional country music scene for many years.

5743114 Trombone Shorty: *Parking Lot Symphony*. New album from New Orleans bandleader, his first for Blue Note, incorporating jazz, funk, R&B and rock influences into his joyous brass band format.

BSEJR001 Jason Ricci & New Blood: *Live At Checkers Tavern*. Little known 2004 live set from Iowa by a then young hot-shot blues harmonica player and singer, who later went on to play alongside the likes of Johnny Winter, Walter Trout, Ana Popovic, Joe Louis Walker, The Mannish Boys and many others, as well as record his own albums (most recently for Delta Groove). Leading a fine band (incorporating the blues rock guitar of Shawn Starksy), this features seven extended jam numbers, mostly originals but with some covers - including a stand out and elongated version of Little Walter's *Blue & Lonesome*.

CDCOMM211 Sam Gleaves And Tyler Hughes: *Sam Gleaves And Tyler Hughes*. Guitar, banjo and harmony singing duets of deep Appalachian traditional sounds from Southwest Virginia.

COM46772 Shannon McNally: *Black Irish*. New album of bluesy Americana songs produced by Rodney Crowell. Three of the tracks are self written but, even allowing for covers of songs from the likes of Stevie Wonder, J.J. Cale, Robbie Robertson and others, this is her most personal project yet.

CJA00055 John Pizzarelli: *Sinatra & Jobim @ 50*. Jazz guitarist commemorates the fiftieth anniversary of one of his favourite albums; a collaboration between Frank Sinatra and Antonio Carlos Jobim. This includes Pizzarelli's own unique take on the songs from this album plus a few extra tracks that celebrate the two masters.

5756114 Chuck Berry: *Chuck*. His first studio album in decades and, sadly, his final album as he passed away at the age of 90 before it was released. Very well received by critics, Chuck clearly still had something special right to the end.

5761782 Louis Hayes: *Serenade For Horace*. Label debut from esteemed jazz drummer with his own 11 track tribute to his one-time employer, the great jazz pianist and bandleader, Horace Silver. Gregory Porter guests on the standout version of *Song For My Father*.

5714901 Imelda May: *Life Love Flesh Blood*. New album and change of direction from feisty Irish rock and roll singer. On this album, Imelda has engaged the production skills of T-Bone Burnett and the band that formed the core group on the Grammy Award winning album *Raising Sand* by Robert Plant and Alison Krauss (being Marc Ribot on guitar, Jay Bellerose on drums and Zach Dawes on bass). On her most personal and intimate album to date, other guests include Jeff Beck and Jools Holland.

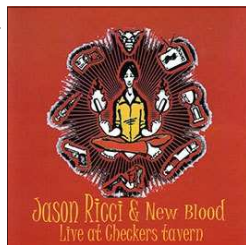

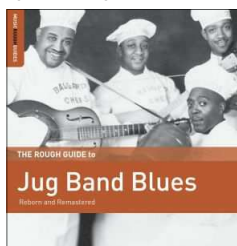
