Lots of great jazz musicians on show, including Jo Jo Jones, Jimmy Jones, Thad Jones, Billy Mitchell, Frank Wess, Freddie Green and more.

FSRCD948 Lucky Thompson: In Paris 1960. Two radio broadcasts from popular saxophonist, one at the Modern Jazz Club, Club Saint Germain and the other from the Blue Note

FSRCD945 André Hodeir: Complete Paris & New York Sessions. Four complete albums from highly literate jazz composer recorded in 1950s and the beginnings of 1960s.

GH66724 Stanley Turrentine & Grant Green Quintet: Complete Recordings. The only four sessions involving legends of jazz saxophone and jazz guitar. Most of these sessions were first issued on three Blue Note albums (Live At Minton's Vols 1 & 2 and Z.T.'s Blues), but this also includes three tracks from an obscure session led by trumpeter Dizzy Reece.

HARP7731 Backtrack Blues Band: Make My Home In Florida. Accomplished Florida blues band light up the stage at the Palladium Theatre in their home state, mixing dynamic originals plus corking versions of classic blues tracks such as *T-Bone Shuffle*, *Nobody But You* and *Your Funeral And My Trial*. High energy blues with the blues harp and vocals of Sonny Charles and guitar of Kid Royal to the fore.

JASMD3705 Billy Walker: Well, Hello There - The Country Chart Hits And More 1954-1962. The early hits of 'The Tall Texan', 30 impressive cuts of country, rockabilly, pop and more: a perfect introduction to this most versatile of hit makers.

JASCD987 Carla Thomas: The Memphis Princess - Early Recordings 1960-1962. Her first album in its entirety (and in stereo) plus early singles, including four duets with her equally famous father, Rufus Thomas. A fine introduction to the early career of a soul legend.

JASMD2638 Various: New Orleans - Original Film Soundtrack. A 22 track soundtrack album to

the 1947 motion picture first issued on lp by Giants Of Jazz. While the movie was Billie Holiday's only full length film, it hasn't gone down in movie history as a classic but the soundtrack album presented here features veritable treats from the likes of Lady Day herself, Louis Armstrong, Kid Ory, Zutty Singleton, Barney Bigard, Bud Scott, Charlie Beal, Meade Lux Lewis and others.

JASCD847 Various: Mambo Americano - 63 Mambo-Tastic Tracks From The American Dance Craze! A fun-packed selection of Mambo-inspired recordings, mostly from the mid-1950s involving Wynonie Harris, Rosco Gordon, Sonny Thompson, Earl Bostic, Johnny Otis, Billy Boyd, Ivory Joe Hunter, Chuck Higgins, The Robins, The Dootones, John Lee Hooker, The Harptones and many more.

JAZZ VILLAGE CD £14.95

JV570136 Ahmad Jamal: Marseille. New 8 track album from legendary jazz pianist, now 87 years old and recipient of 2017 Grammy Lifetime Achievement Award. As well as demonstrating his usual range of musical talents, this album also features artwork designed by Ahmad himself.

JSP77209 Various: I Ain't A Gamblin' Woman, I Got Such-A Rowdy Ways. A fascinating set of 'classic blues' women singers from the 1920s and 1930s. Compiled and annotated by Max Haymes and featuring plenty of artists and sides not easily found elsewhere, this has 103 re-mastered sides - a CD each dedicated to Clara Smith, Lucille Bogan and Lil Johnson plus a disc including tracks from Moaning Bernice Edwards (14 tracks), Sippie Wallace (4 tracks), Bessie Tucker (4 tracks), Hociel Thomas (2 tracks) and Victoria Spivey (1 track).

JSP77205 Various: Louisiana Swamp Blues Vol 2. Follow up to the immensely popular first volume (*Louisiana Swamp Blues - JSP77180*), this features another 87 crackers from the depths of the Louisiana swamps from between 1945-1963, incorporating blues, rhythm & blues, swamp pop, Cajun and more. Well known and barely-heard of artists abound - Lonesome Sundown, Lightnin' Slim, Nathan Abshire, Clarence Garlow, Boo Breeding, Tabby Thomas, Vince Monroe, Shelton Dunaway, Jay Stutes, Guitar Junior, Katie Webster, Schoolboy Cleve & many others.

CDKEND477 George Jackson: Leavin' Your Homework Undone. 24 previously unheard and unissued tracks recorded by stylish soul singer between 1968 and 1971. Effectively the fourth volume in the series of issuing Jackson's great southern soul catalogue, this features the marvellous Fame rhythm section, on many tracks while other songs are just raw demos.

A great run through of classic sides at a time when his commercial and artistic mojo had been re-invigorated by his recent Blue Sky recordings.

First album from jazz super-group collective featuring four of the world's leading musicians - Jack DeJohnette (drums), Larry Grenadier (bass), John Medeski (keyboards) and John Scofield (guitar). A fine 11 track set including original compositions plus jazzed up versions of songs by Bob Dylan, Joni Mitchell, Jimi Hendrix and Robbie Robertson.

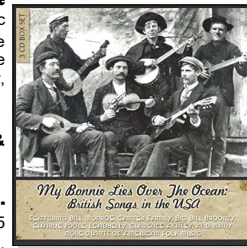
