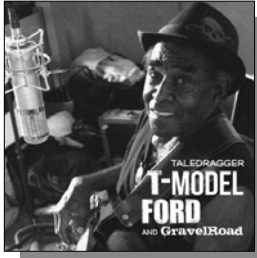

CH86 BB King: *Live At The Regal*. Best live blues LP ever.

ALIVE LP £14.55

ALIVE0115LP T-Model Ford And Gravelroad: *Tale-dragger*. Vinyl version of new album of super bluesman, now into his nineties but still capable of producing good ole' juke-jointin' raucous blues. With 8 studio recordings made with current touring band during a 2010 US tour. Compelling and hypnotic, as always (for CD version, ask for ALIVE0115CD - £13.35). The vinyl version, at the moment at least, comes as a limited edition coloured vinyl!



BEAR FAMILY LP £17.75

BAF18006 Jerry Lee Lewis: *Live At The Star Club Hamburg*. Possibly the best live recording ever made, definitely the best rock'n'roll record anyway. This is Jerry Lee in 1964 making men out of the Nashville Teens who back him on this all-out blistering set of his greatest hits plus some other folks greatest hits which he makes all his own! The LP contains possibly his best ever version of Whole Lotta Shakin' and wait til you hear him rip into the two part epic What'd I Say or the one extra track, the thundering (Move On) Down The Line!!! Actually, forget the CD issues, vinyl is the only way to hear a classic like this. If you don't own Live At The Star Club, you've no excuses now!!

BEWARE001LP Various Artists: *Wavy Gravy*. Subtitled 'For adult enthusiasts...', this has 14 amazing cuts from demented nutcases doing what comes naturally (to them at least). Crazy garage, surf, rockabilly, B-movie rejects, novelty ditties, and more available again on vinyl after years in the wilderness. NED6 The Cramps: *Smell Of Female*. One of the most entertaining live albums ever, recorded at the legendary Peppermint Lounge. Contains only 6 tracks, this is more of an extended EP of the band in their prime. Stonking originals ('The Most Exalted Potentate Of Love') and superbly chosen covers (including the persuasive 'Faster Pussycat', the title track from the legendary Russ Meyer movie).

BLM0202 Elmo Williams & Hezekiah Early: *American Made (10" LP)*. Highly regarded but, until recently, hard to find album, now available again in the UK.

Sixteen tracks from his 1940s/50s singles. Originally slated to come out on the Whiskey Women And.. vinyl label but never did!

GET54038LP Howlin' Wolf: *The Howlin' Wolf Album*.

This is the album that Cadet thought would propel the Wolf into the jet stream by mixing psychedelic electric guitars and rock elements with the blues. Cadet had an inkling it wouldn't please the "hard blues" audience by sub-titling it "This Is Howlin' Wolf's New LP, He Doesn't Like It. He Didn't Like His Electric Guitar At First Either". The LP was issued in 1969 much to Wolf's dismay (he called it "dogshit") and jeering derision by hardcore Chicago blues fans but the dangd thang went and attained mythical proportions over the years due to the controversy behind it. Dedicated blues fans and rock aficionados are still searching it out forty odd years later and loving it when they find it!

Now's your chance with this top quality reissue, pressed in big shot Stoughton vinyl with audio re-mastered from original analogue tapes for sound you wouldn't believe and comes in a pasted-on style jacket with original artwork.

GET54042LP Muddy Waters: *After The Rain*. Classic late period Chess album from Muddy on lovely vinyl. Follow up to the psychedelic experiment of *Electric Mud*, this 1969 Chess album makes more use of traditional Muddy singing and playing styles and is all the better for it.
